

In Congress June 29th 1790.

Ordered,

That warrants be drawn in favor of the Treasurer of the United States on the Treasurers of the several States from New Hampshire to Maryland inclusive for their respective proportions of the ten million dollars specially called for by the resolution of the 19th of May last. And that expresses be dispatched with the same accompanied with a letter from the President of Congress to the Executive powers of the said States.

That warrants be also drawn in favor of the Treasurer of the United States on the Treasurers of the several States abovementioned for the remainder of their quotas of assessments due to the first of March last inclusive, and sent by the same expresses.
