Sir

We are Honoured with your Letter of the 4<sup>th</sup> Feb<sup>r</sup> with sundry inclosures, to which we shall pay due attention, and endeavour to answer fully P<sup>r</sup> next Post. —

A Petition from the Officers of the Connecticut Line to the Legislature of that State, similar to that you inclose was some time ago layd before Congress, on which there is now a report of a Committee under consideration, we flatter ourselves something will be done in the matter, but what we cannot at present say. —

The Legislatures of Massachusetts Bay and Connecticut have taken measures to quiet the uneasiness of their Troops, Perhaps similar measures might be adopted with success by the Legislature of New Hampshire
