Early this afternoon Max Pious

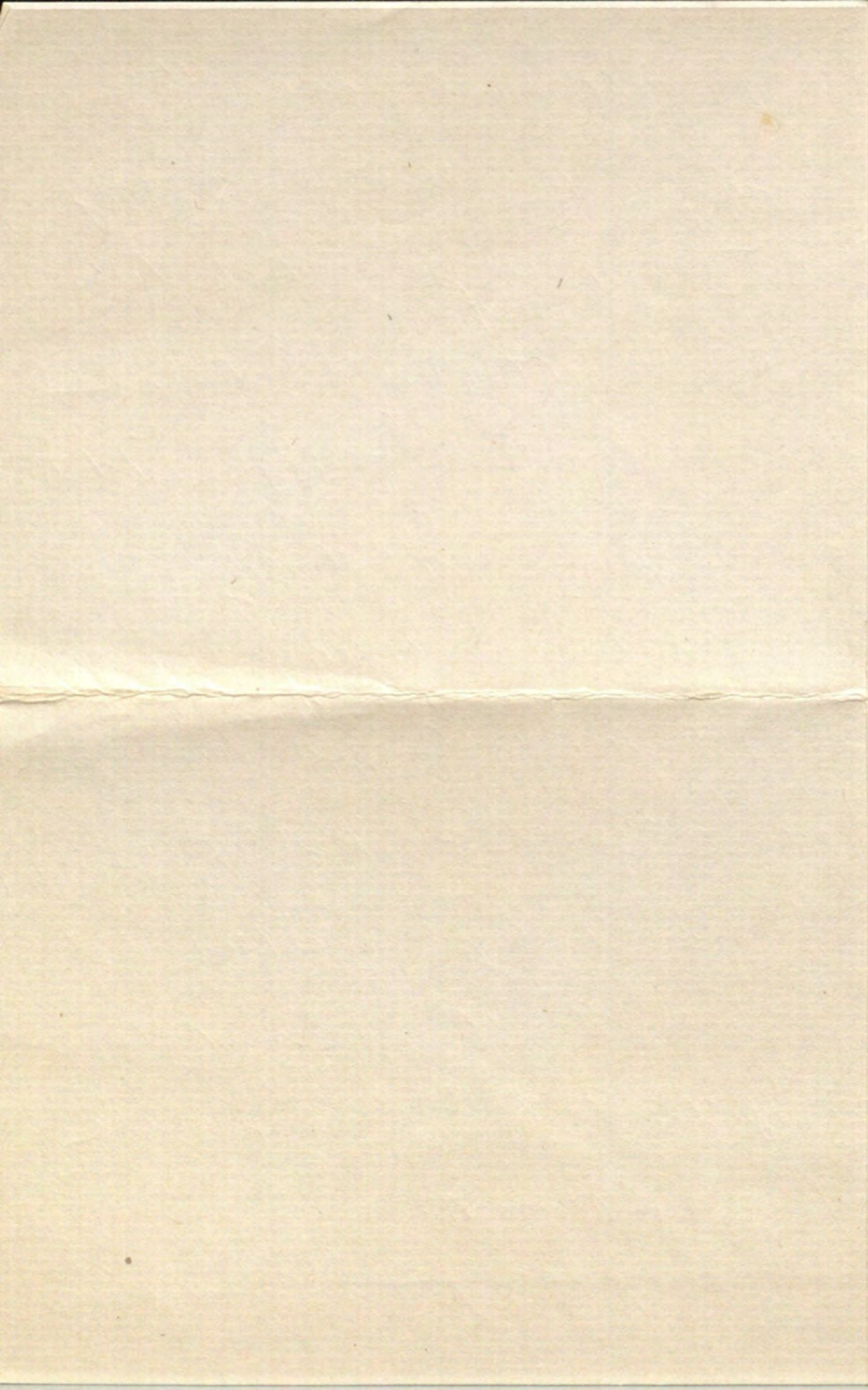
called and later on I spoke

to be remembered to you, my sweet heart.

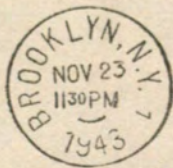
We've had no snow as yet and
