Resolved, That a copy of Genl. Washington's Letter of the 10th and the estimate of tents and other Camp equipage wanted for the Army accompanying the same be transmitted to the Supreme Executive powers to the States of New Hampshire, Massachusetts, Rhode-Island & Connecticut, & that they be requested to take such measures as they may judge will be most speedy and effectual for procuring within the said States respectively the portions mentioned in the estimate or as great a part thereof as may be had especially of the most essential kinds

Resolved, That the same assurances which were given to the subscribers to a bank in Pennsylvania by resolutions of Congress of June 22^d last past be and hereby are given for the reimbursement of the expences which shall be incurred by a compliance with the foregoing resolution —
