Garrison Saratoga July 23. 1782

Sir

I beg leave to acquaint your Hon^{ty} that as the promotion of Lt. Asa Senter of the 1st. N. M. Reg^t. vice Cap. Sartwell resigned, hapened on the 12th. of May 1781 a vacancy for Ensign John Harvy of the same Reg^t. hapened on the same day for a Lieutenant vice Lt. Senter promoted, the date of which vacancy I was not able to ascertain when in New Hampshire, as the vacancy is of long standing I wish the promotion for M^r. Harvy might be made as soon as the Hon^{ty}. Court shall think proper. — there is nothing new in this quarter, the Enemy have been

in a considerable body, on the Mohawk River
last week, they made an attack on the out
posts on that river but were repulsed, they
carried off a considerable number of cattle
& some prisoners, they have established
a Post at Oswego, & I fear will be very
troublesome on the frontiers, their small
parties skelp or carry off more or less of
the 2^d Reg^t. every few days. —
