

In Congress 7th May 1779 --

Resolved,

That it be and it is hereby earnestly recom-
-mended to the States of New Hampshire, Massachusetts
Bay, and Connecticut, to furnish and keep up
constantly in the State of Rhode Island & Providence
plantations, their several quotas of troops as adjusted
by the resolution of a committee from the said States
and the State of New York which met at Springfield
in the State of Massachusetts bay the 30th day of July 1777.
